I have just completed a final inspection of your beautifully built and completed Mikva. In addition, I have been involved in the planning and implementation of the plans in conjunction with other Rabbonim from the onset of construction.

**The Mikva clearly meets all Halachic guidelines and laws set forth, and is Kosher L'Mhadrin min Hamihadrin.**

The Mikva consists of three Bati Tevillo. Two of these Bati Tevillo have each a Hashoko Bor and a Zeriyoh Bor which is a Bor al Gabi Bor. The third Bais Hatevillo is built according to the custom of Lubavitch, and has a Bor under the Bais Hatevillo. In addition this third Bor has a Bor Zeriyoh. All the water coming into each of the Boros Hazeriyoh come over Hamshocho.

The water coming into the Boros from the roof, come from an isolated part of the roof on which there is no type of machine or other possibility of a Keli. The drops from the roof are done by direct pipes, with attachments or bends.

In light of the above, the Mikva is clearly Kosher L'Chatchilo and meets the customs of all traditions.

In addition to the Halachic requirements, the aesthetics of the Mikva have been planned and implemented with careful precision, creating a truly beautiful edifice. This not only is a Hidur Mitzvoh, but will surely enhance Mikva observance through the entire region.

May HKB"H bless you and help you go Mai Chayil el Coyil, and continue the building and blossoming your community in the ways of the Torah.
